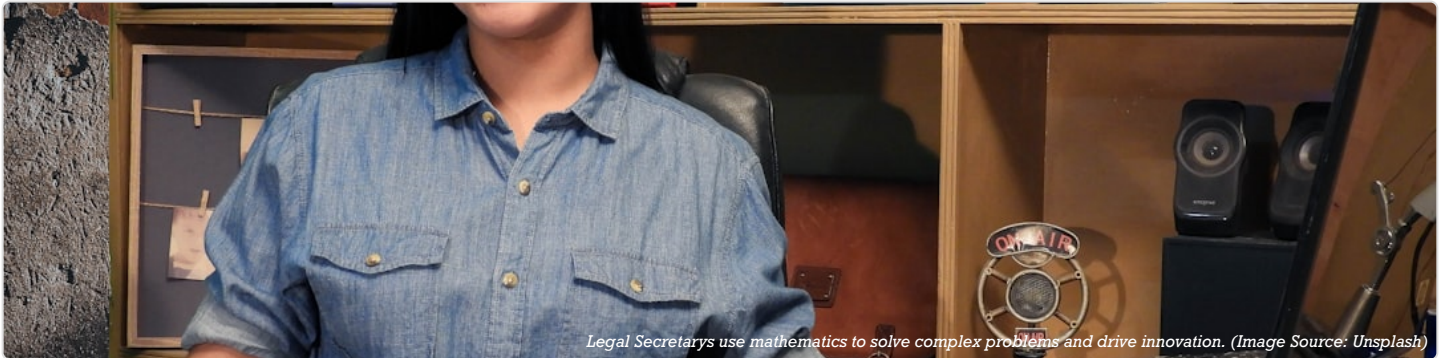


CAREERS THROUGH MATHS: LEGAL SECRETARY

JOB OVERVIEW

- **Measurement & Unit Conversion:** Accurately converting measurements in cases involving personal injury, property disputes, or technical evidence.
